Whilst the minimum for a Mass stipend was set by the Bishops of Scotland in 1990 at £5, with inflation etc this would be more like a £15 minimum in 2025. Your donation/stipend should contain some sacrifice on your part “pray brethren that my sacrifice and yours...” involves both a spiritual and material offering of ourselves. Mass stipends are the ordinary way by which the clergy are expected to supplement their income (the parish provides £299 per month as a “wage” to each priest) through the free will offerings of the faithful. Thank you for your generosity in advance, and please do continue to ask for Mass intentions for both the living and the dead. Padre Pio said that
