Please bring your blessed palms from last year so that they can be burnt for ashes to be distributed on Ash Wednesday.

Wednesdays at 7pm: **catechesis, prayer life and the precepts and traditions of the church.** These are particularly designed for those receiving instruction to be baptised, received into the church or confirmed, but also for those who were baptised, received or came to back to the practice of the faith in the last five years. This week the topic is **The Creation of the World.**

Please bring your blessed palms from last year so that they can be burnt for ashes to be distributed on Ash Wednesday. This year **Ash Wednesday falls on Wednesday 18th February,** Mass times are 8am, 12:30pm & 5:45pm and there will be the distribution of ashes at each of these.

On The Feast of the Holy Face, Shrove Tuesday, 17th February, there will be confessions from 11:30am followed by 12:30pm Mass. At 5:45pm there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament followed by Mass at 6:45pm in Honour of the Holy Face. The Holy Face Novena begins today, 8th February, and ends on the feast, please feel free to take the novena with you and share with others. There will be a pancake party afterwards.

TRIDUUM OF OUR LADY OF LOURDES
8TH - 11TH FEBRUARY

The liturgical memorial of the 11th of February, marking the first apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Saint Bernadette at Lourdes, shall be preceded by a Triduum of Prayer. During these days, we shall entrust unto the Virgin Mary all the sick and the intentions of those suffering in body and spirit. When a French priest from the National Pilgrimage proposed in 1888 to hold a procession with the Blessed Sacrament in Lourdes, a miraculous healing took place. Since then, the sick who go on pilgrimage to Lourdes are blessed with the Blessed Sacrament, and countless miraculous healings have occurred as the Holy Sacrament passes by. The Sanctuary of Lourdes is a radiant example of faith in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

We warmly invite all to participate with devotion and to join our community in great numbers.
